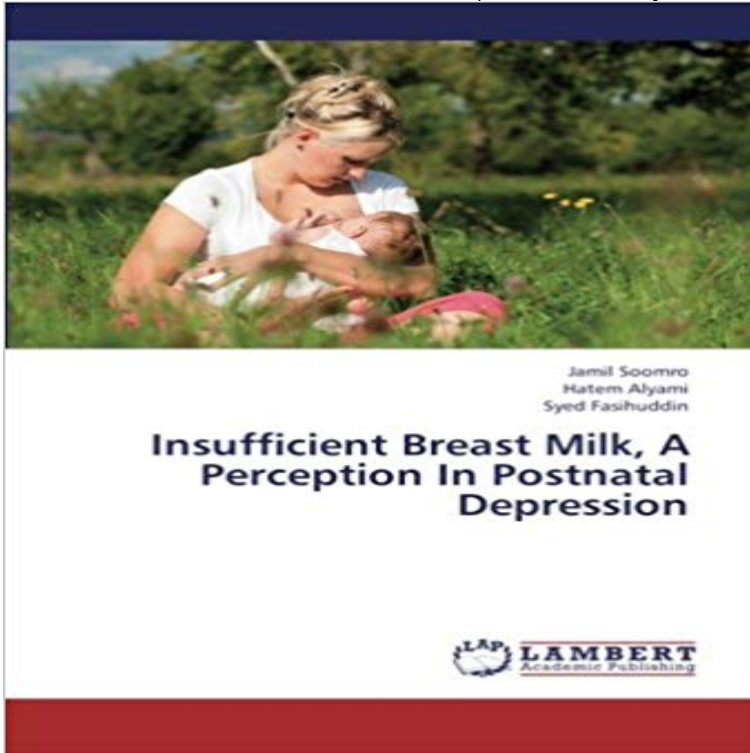


# Insufficient Breast Milk, A Perception In Postnatal Depression

We found that Depressive symptomatology in the postpartum period negatively influences infant feeding outcomes. These findings have important clinical implications and support the need for early identification and treatment of women with depressive symptomatology.
